

Yet again the Covid pessimists have been proved wrong. These peddlers of doom predicted the near-complete easing of restrictions on July 19 would lead to a dramatic spike in infections, creating a public health disaster.

Neil Ferguson, aka 'Professor Lockdown' and the scaremonger-in-chief on the official Scientific Advisory Group for Emergencies (Sage), warned that the number of new daily cases could rise to 100,000 to 200,000. Thankfully this grim scenario has not materialised.

The number of new infections has maintained a steady and significant decline since Freedom Day, falling to 21,952 cases on Monday, the lowest daily figure for more than a month.

Nor has there been any surge in hospitalisations or deaths.

Breaking: Domestic Restrictions Reimposed in Iceland

A 200-person gathering limit, one-metre distancing, and restricted opening hours for bars and nightclubs will be reimposed in <u>Iceland</u> just four weeks after all domestic restrictions due to COVID-19 were lifted. The restrictions are based on recommendations from Chief Epidemiologist Þórólfur Guðnason and were decided on at a lengthy cabinet meeting today. At a briefing in Reykjavík yesterday, Þórólfur stated that COVID case numbers were rising at an <u>exponential rate</u> despite the country's high vaccination rates.

On June 26, Iceland lifted all domestic restrictions due to COVID-19, one year and four months after the very first social restrictions were imposed due to the pandemic. The country also loosened border restrictions on July 1, allowing travellers with proof of vaccination or previous infection to enter the country without testing or quarantine. Infection rates have risen over the past two weeks, and Iceland now reports 371 active cases, up from 60 cases just eight days ago.

L'Islanda è uno dei Paesi del mondo meno colpiti in assoluto dalla pandemia di Covid-19, grazie alla conformazione naturale del territorio: si tratta di un'isola molto lontana da altre aree abitate, con appena 350 mila abitanti e con un sistema sanitario molto efficiente che ha consentito l'attuazione di test a tappeto per individuare i casi positivi e isolare i focolai sul nascere. Così in tutto il Paese dall'inizio della pandemia abbiamo avuto soltanto 7.801 casi positivi e 30 morti, con uno dei tassi di mortalità in assoluto più bassi al mondo.

L'arrivo del vaccino è stato poi accolto con grande speranza nel Paese che si è sempre contraddistinto per una forte fiducia nei confronti della scienza, con cui ha costanti relazioni per la necessità di adottare misure di prevenzione dai rischi naturali a cui l'isola è esposta (terremoti, eruzioni vulcaniche, inondazioni e tempeste meteorologiche). In poco tempo, quindi, tutti gli abitanti islandesi vaccinabili sono stati vaccinati: ad oggi il 78,48% della popolazione ha ricevuto la prima dose, il 74,33% la seconda. Considerando che le vaccinazioni non sono state autorizzate per bambini e ragazzi fino ai 16 anni (che in Islanda sono circa 75.000), la totalità degli islandesi con più di 16 anni ha ricevuto il vaccino anti-Covid.

Fiduciose di aver risolto il problema, le autorità il 26 giugno hanno revocato tutte le restrizioni anti-Covid, riaperto tutti i locali e dichiarato la fine dell'emergenza.

Adesso, però, in pochi giorni la situazione è precipitata. Dal 20 Luglio è iniziata una nuova ondata che in pochi giorni si è già rivelata la più intensa dall'inizio della pandemia.

Some 143 Israelis were hospitalized with COVID-19 as of Wednesday at 12 p.m., according to the Health Ministry. Fifty-eight percent of them were vaccinated, 39% were not and 3% were partially vaccinated, meaning they had taken one dose or a full week had not passed since their second shot.

We remember the jubilant news: "Vaccination world champion Israel". Israel was seen as a role model, especially by Western politicians. In the meantime, however, things have gone quiet around the supposed model country. No wonder: the results of the broad "through vaccination" of the population with the controversial, new spike protein injections are devastating. It is primarily the "vaccinated" who are infected with Corona. They end up in the hospital particularly often because of it, as one Israeli doctor notes.

- He says, "It seems that the efficacy of vaccination is close to zero.
- Vaccinated people seem to get seriously ill more often.
- More than twice as many hospitalizations among Israelis with the spike protein injection.

Rafael Zioni posted Israel's Corona statistics on his Twitter page. They are the official data from the Israeli Ministry of Health.

Dr. Zioni is an internist at Israel's Laniado Hospital. He knows what he is talking about. Most Corona infections and associated hospitalizations in Israel affect vaccinated people. The broad vaccination coverage of the population naturally leaves fewer unvaccinated people. But these seem to survive Corona infections on average even better than those who have already received two doses of the Pfizer serum.



"These are Israeli data on the outbreak of infections among those vaccinated with two Pfizer doses. It seems that the efficiency is close to zero," he explains.





Preliminary data were collected from June 2006 through October 2009 on 715,000 patients, and 1.4 million doses (of 45 different vaccines) were given to 376,452 individuals. Of these doses, 35,570 possible reactions (2.6 percent of vaccinations) were identified. This is an average of 890 possible events, an average of 1.3 events per clinician, per month. These data were presented at the 2009 AMIA conference.

In addition, ESP:VAERS investigators participated on a panel to explore the perspective of clinicians, electronic health record (EHR) vendors, the pharmaceutical industry, and the FDA towards systems that use proactive, automated adverse event reporting.

Adverse events from drugs and vaccines are common, but underreported. Although 25% of ambulatory patients experience an adverse drug event, less than 0.3% of all adverse drug events and 1-13% of serious events are reported to the Food and Drug Administration (FDA). Likewise, fewer than 1% of vaccine adverse events are reported. Low reporting rates preclude or slow the identification of "problem" drugs and vaccines that endanger public health. New surveillance methods for drug and vaccine adverse effects are needed. Barriers to reporting include a lack of clinician awareness, uncertainty about when and what to report, as well as the burdens of reporting: reporting is not part of clinicians' usual workflow, takes time, and is duplicative. Proactive, spontaneous, automated adverse event reporting imbedded within EHRs and other information systems has the potential to speed the identification of problems with new drugs and more careful quantification of the risks of older drugs.

Unfortunately, there was never an opportunity to perform system performance assessments because the necessary CDC contacts were no longer available and the CDC consultants responsible for receiving data were no longer responsive to our multiple requests to proceed with testing and evaluation.

A doomsday new Covid variant that could kill up to one in three people is a 'realistic possibility', according to the Government's top scientists.

Documents published by the Scientific Advisory Group for Emergencies (SAGE) today warned a future strain could be as deadly as MERS — which has a case fatality rate of 35 per cent — could be on the way.

No10's expert panel claimed the likelihood of the virus mutating is highest when it is most prevalent — as is currently the case in Britain.

And in a downside of Britain's hugely successful vaccination drive, the team warned the country's greater levels of immunity may help speed up the virus's evolutionary process.

Rolling out booster vaccines this winter and curbing transmission may help prevent a mutant strain occurring, according to the paper.
